ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above, the Government had released a Sum of Rs 324,60,62,000 /- towards Additional Instalment of Grants-in-aid as Central Share under Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) for the year 2017-18.

2. In the letter second read above the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has stated that the Government of India have released a sum of Rs.324,60,62,000/- to the State Government towards additional installment of Grant-in-aid as Central Share under Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) for the year 2017-18 as detailed below:

The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has further stated that based on the earlier release of Government of India, the Government have issued orders in G.O (Ms) No 44, Rural Development and Panchayat Raj(CGS-1) Department, dated 22.03.2018 for the release of Central Share of Rs.324,60,62,000/- under Swachh Bharat Mission(G) for the year 2017-18 and also informed that the Government have not sanctioned the corresponding State Matching Share of Rs.216,40,42,000/- under Swachh Bharat Mission(G) for the year 2017-18.

4. The Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj has therefore requested the Government to sanction a sum of Rs.216,40,42,000/- (Rupees Two hundred and sixteen crore forty lakh and forty two thousand only) as Corresponding State Matching Share (40%) on Central Share of additional instalment of grants-in-aid under Swachh Bharat Mission(G) for the year 2017-18.

5. The Government, after careful examination of the proposal of the Director of Rural Development and Panchayat Raj accord sanction for a sum of Rs.216,40,42,000/- (Two hundred sixteen crore forty lakh and forty two thousand only) as State share towards the additional instalment of Grant-in-aid under Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin) for the year 2017-18.
