#### NOTIFICATION

In exercise o;f the powers conferred bythe sub-section(1) of Section 198 of the Tamil Nadu Panchayats Act, 1994 (Tamil Nadu Act 21 of 1994), the Governor of Tamil Nadu hereby constitutes a Finance Commission referred to in Article 243-I of the Constitution, with a Chairman and four other Members. Thiru M.A.Gowrishankar, I.A.S. is appointed as a Member who will be the Member-Secretary of the Commission.

- 2. The Chairman and other members of the Commission shall hold office from the date on which they respectively assume office upto the 31st day of October 1995.
- 3. The Commission shall review the financial position of the panchayats and make recommendations as to:-
  - (a) the principles which should govern,-
- (i) the distribution between the State and panchayats of the net proceeds of the taxes, duties, tolls and fees leviable by the Government which may be divided between them, and allocation between the district panchayats panchayat union councils and village panchayats of their respective shares of such proceeds;
- (ii) the determination of the taxes, duties, tolls and fees which may be assigned to or appropriated by the panchayats;
  - (iii) the grants-in-aid to the panchayats, from the Consolidated Fund of the State;
  - (b) the measures needed to improve the financial position of the Panchayats.
  - 4. In reviewing the financial position of the panchayats, the Commission shall,-

- (i) assess the financial position of the Panchayat unions as on 31st March1994 with reference to revenue receipts and expenditure and the debt position;
- (ii) assess, as far as may be practicable, the financial position of the villagepanchayats as on 31st March 1994 with reference to revenue receipts and expenditure.
- 5. In making its recommendations, the Commission shall have regard, to the resources of the State Government, the demand thereon and the need to generate adequate surplus on revenue account for State's commitments on capital account.
  - 6. The Commission shall also have regard to:-
- (i) the existing level of devolution of resources to the Panchayats and the adequacy of such devolution;
  - (ii) the maintenance and upkeep of capital assets owned by, or entrusted to, the panchayats;
  - (iii) the tax efforts of the panchayats and incentives to increase such tax efforts.
- 7. The Commission may suggest changes, if any, in the existing classification of panchayat unions on the basis of their financial position.
- 8. The Commission may suggest measure to improve financial management of panchayats and to reduce unproductive expenditure in Panchayats.
- 9. The Commission shall make its report available by 31st October 1995, covering the period of five years commencing on 1st April 1997.

The terms of reference issued to this Task Force were as follows:-

- 1. a. Reconstitution of Village Panchayats Town Panchayats, Municipalities and Corporations Fixing norms based on population, area etc.
- b. Classification, re-classification of Village Panchayats, Panchayat Union Councils, Town Panchayats, Municipalities, Municipal Corporations for the purpose of Government assistance/administrative convenience.
- c. Review of the staff strength sanctioned to the Local Bodies including recruitment procedure redeployment, fixing norms for creation with reference to the devolution of powers to the Rural and Urban Local Bodies contemplated in the 11th and 12th Schedule of the Constitution and Schedule (iv) of the Tamil Nadu Panchayats Act 1994 and Schedule 10 of the District Municipalities Act 1920 and Schedule of the Municipal Corporation Act and also the workload position upto 2002. Periodical training of staff in the proper maintenance of accounts and in administration.

- d. Review of the Technical staff sanctioned to Local Bodies with reference to the workload, Administrative and Technical control, measures to strengthen the system including periodical training to the staff. Training local residents (select) with the help of N.G.Os. for effective maintenance of core civic services.
- e. Review of adequacy of powers of Local Bodies for effective implementation of schemes viz., Schemes of their own and also State and Centrally sponsored and externally aided. Need for liberalisation and delegation of powers.
- f. (a) Review of the works procedure, rules for calling tenders, Technical and Administrative sanction powers for works, sanction of powers for excess over estimates etc.
  - (b) Accountability of the Executing Agencies to the Local Bodies.
- g. Review of the Financial and Accounting procedure in Local Bodies for incurring expenditures, control mechanism, review of the accounts and registers maintained in the Local Bodies and suggest measures for simplification and improvement.
- h. Review of the present system of Audit of the accounts of the Local Bodies and suggesting ways and means for improvement and audit mechanism for Village Panchayats. Fixing joint responsibilities for officials and non-officials for omissions, commissions and mis-use of powers.
- i. Data Base for Local Bodies Computerisation for Civic Services, Administration and for accounts.

Government in G.O. Rt. No.692, Finance (Resources) Department, Dated 27.9.95, sanctioned the required amount to the above Institute. Mid-term reviews were held on 5.11.95, 21.12.95, 23.2.96 and 5.3.96. The final report of this Task Force was submitted to the State Finance Commission on 8.5.1996.

#### II. M/s Kirloskar Consultants Limited - Norms for Core Civic Services

The task force constituted to examine the norms for core civic services and possible areas of privatisation, started to function with effect from 28.9.1995. The following members on the Government side were identified by the above consultants headed by Thiru K.Mukundan, Accociate Vice-President as experts for the proposed study.

- Thiru. P. Dorairaj Additional Director of Rural Development (Rtd.)
- 2) Thiru. Ramalingam Additional Director of Municipal Administration (Rtd.)

Prominent among the Kirloskar Consultants was also Thiru. Brij Gopal Lada who liaisoned with the Tamil Nadu State Finance Commission along with Thiru. K.Mukundan and brought out valuable indices in respect of all Local Bodies. Thiru. S.Ramachandran, Officer on Special Duty, State Finance Commission assisted them with all the information and help required, from time to time

The objectives of their study were as follows:-

- To arrive at norms for the minimum acceptable level for the core services in the various types of Local Bodies both in urban and rural.
- Norms for Operation and Maintenance, for existing services and minimum level of expenditure needed.
- Projection of need for services for the period upto the year 2002.
- 4. The resources needed for providing the minimum level of services and for the Operation and Maintenance on a reasonable level.
- 5. Possibility of induction of private agencies for services and for effective management and economy.

The above institute was also provided with the required finance by the Government. The said Task Force for nor ms for Core Civic Services and Possible area of Privatisation was subjected to mid term review on 23.11.95, 8.1.96, 23.2.96 and 24.5.96. It submitted its final report on 30.7. 1996.

# III. Institute for Financial Management and Research, Madras - Augmentation of Resources

This institute constituted the task force on 'Tax and non-tax resources of the Local Bodies in Tamil Nadu' and launched its programme with effect from 10.10.1995. The members who handled this task force were as follows:-

- Strategy for mobilization of additional resources through existing tax and non-tax sources and the base for rationalization of procedure and plugging loop-holes in collection.
- New tax domains, additional assignment of taxes of the State and widening of tax base through new taxes.
- 4. Adequacy of existing assignment and to suggest additional assignment of taxes of the state to the Local Bodies to determine the principle to govern assignments.
- 5. Principles to govern grants-in-aid.

Mid-term review were held on 24.11.95, 31.1.96 and 30.4.96
